Micro Bead Basics – Clear Beads

To start with – you'll need to gather the items listed on the supply list:

- ❖ Clear Glass No Hole Micro Beads
- ❖ Glass No Hole Micro Beads in 1 or 2 colors of your choice
- ❖ O'So Sticky Tape Sheet (Paperback Tape Sheets can be used as well!)
- ❖ O'So Sticky Tape Roll 1/8" or 1/4" size (doesn't matter!)
- ❖ Cardstock, Stamps, Inks - your choice!
- ❖ Tidy Tray, or shallow plate or tray. Glass and metal work well – no static!
- ❖ Sharp Scissors (We recommend the Tonic Scissors that we carry in our on-line store)
- ❖ Citrus Cleaner (Goo -Gone for example)
- ❖ Optional: An Old Brayer if you have one!



Micro Bead Basics – Using Clear Beads with O’So Step 1



To start, I have stamped the words “Make A Wish” onto a 2” square piece of cardstock.

Next, I cut a piece of O’So Sticky Tape from the Original Sheet – this piece is also 2” square.

Micro Bead Basics – Using Clear Beads with O’So Step 2

Next, I peeled back JUST A CORNER of the paper liner.

I chose to peel the PAPER side (white color) first, so that I could “see through” the red liner to line up my tape and stamped square.

Once I got all lined up the top left corner of the tape to the top left corner of the stamped square, I pressed down on the corner and THEN peeled the rest of the paper off – so that my O’So Sticky square covered my image – like this:

All that was left to do after that was peel off the red liner, and press my image into the tray of clear beads! I like to “smoosh” them in good using an old brayer!
